- Minimal foul odor
- With 3 chamber septic tanks
- Lack of environmental permits such as Discharge Permit, (PCO) Pollution Control Officer and hazardous wastes generator I.D

In regards with the above-mentioned issue, MENRO cited the following recommendations to address the said issue. The lists of recommendations are as follows:

### Recommendations:

- · Practice proper solid wastes segregation
- Establish Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) for proper storage of solid wastes
- · Avoid getting the garbage wet to prevent foul odor
- Secure environmental permits such as Discharge Permit, (PCO) Pollution Control Officer, hazardous
  wastes generator I.D, and Cert. of final disposal for toxic and hazardous wastes to the EMB
  (Environmental Management Bureau)
- · The permit holder shall submit quarterly self- monitoring report to City-ENRO

### PERMIT TO OPERATE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY

Pursuant to Section 49 of the Revised Environmental Code of the Province of Bulacan, Provincial Ordinance No. C-005, and by virtue of Section 17, par .3 (iii) of the 1991 Local Government Code, the Provincial Government of Bulacan hereby grants this **Permit to Operate** to **R-DEL'S PREMIUM FOODS INC.** located at #372 F. Lara St., Bgy. Subic, Baliuag, Bulacan, to operate the following:

One (1) unit three-chamber oil and water separator having a total capacity of 4.0 cubic meters.

Subject to the following conditions: That-

- All wastewater/ effluent discharges shall be within the standards set forth in the Revised Environmental Code of the Province of Bulacan, Provincial Ordinance No. C-005;
- Proper collection/handling and disposal of all type of wastes including sludge must be regularly observed and maintenance of Wastewater Treatment Facility (WTF) including the premises must be regularly conducted;
- Application for renewal of this Permit must be filed within thirty (30) days before its
  expiry date. Failure to do so will be a ground for legal action against the permittee for
  violation of Section 54 of the Revised Environmental Code of the Province of
  Bulacan;
- 4. Unless sooner revoked, this Permit is valid until 2 1 NOV 2024
- 5 This permit shall be posted in a conspicuous location within the premises and shall be adequately framed or otherwise protected against damage;
- The proponent is required to conduct effluent sampling/ testing (physico-chemical analysis) every six months (semestral) and submit the result to this Office for proper evaluation and monitoring process; and
- 7. The issuance of this permit is the eleventh (11th) application of said establishment.

Non-compliance with any of the above condition shall be sufficient ground for this Office to impose a penalty of Php 5,000.00 and/or revocation of PECC issued and non-renewal of this Permit to Operate.
