On September 14, 2023, the environmental monitoring of City- ENRO Baliwag conducted an inspection on the compliances of the Respondent (UNITOP Baliwag) in relation to environmental laws and permits. Finding showed that Respondent failed to secure and comply to the Following:

- Wastewater Discharge Permit
- · Proper disposal of Liquid wastes
- Permit to Operate Air Pollution Source Installation
- · Hazardous Wastes Generator ID
- Environmental Compliance Certificate

We have already served them the following notices 1st notice (October 18, 2023), 2st notice (November 13, 2023) 3st notice (February 27, 2024) and yet they are still incompliant with the imposed environmental guidelines of the local and national law. For your reference, attached herewith is the furnished copy of inspection reports.

In view hereof, may we ask from your good office to provide us recommendations and necessary actions needed for this matter subject to your guidelines and favorable evaluation.



Findings.

- Improper disposal of liquid wastes to the irrigation canal
- Wastes water examination result shows a high amount of Ammonia and (BOD) Biochemical Oxygen Demand to the treated wastes water (effluent)
- Lack of environmental permits such as Discharge Permit, Hazardous Wastes Generator LD and Permit to operate air pollution source installation (PTO)

In regards with the above-mentioned issue, MENRO cited the following recommendations to address the said issue. The lists of recommendations are as follows:

Recommendations.

- Ensure that the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) is working properly and all the parameters has passed the
 required result before the discharging of treated wastes water (effluent)
- Secure environmental permits such as Discharge Permit, Hazardous wastes generator I.D. Permit to
 operate air pollution source installation (PTO) and Cert. of final disposal for toxic and hazardous wastes
 to the EMB (Environmental Management Bureau)
- The permit holder shall submit quarterly self- monitoring report to City-ENRO

Also, we will conduct quarterly monitoring on the said Establishment to ensure their compliance with the following environmental ordinances:

RA 9003 Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000

• RA 8749 The Philippine Clean Air Act

• RA 9275 The Philippine Clean Water Act

RA 6969— Toxic Substances & Hazardous & Nuclear Waste Control Act

* We do advise to make an utgent response in addressing this matter as soon as you received this inspection report. Failure to comply with the recommendations given above will result to restricted operation or much worse, closure of the business.
