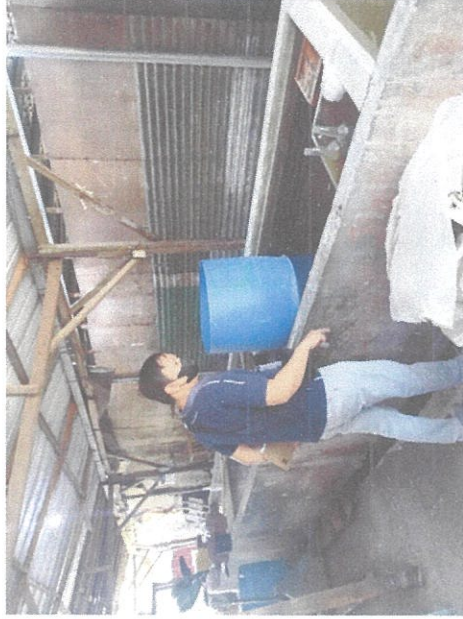

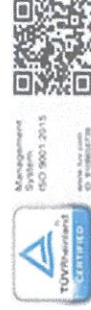

Inspection report: Upon investigation, Monitoring & Inspection Team had come up with the following observations and findings, to with

Findings:

- Without business permit
- Without environmental permits such as Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC), Discharge permit and Hazardous wastes Generator I.D
- Improper disposal of solid wastes (Old bottle label)
- Liquid wastes are directly discharged to the old fish pond.
- To much mosquito larvae are there in the washing tub that may cause to dengue outbreak
- Acid and sosa chemical are used to clean old bottles
- Averaging of 2,112 pcs. or 2 pallets of old bottles are cleaned every day.
- More or less 5 employees.

In regards with the above-mentioned findings, City-ENRO cited the following recommendations to address the said findings. The lists of recommendations are as follows:

Recommendations:

- Secure environmental permits such as Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC), Discharge permit and Hazardous wastes Generator I.D to the EMB (Environmental Management Bureau)
- Practice proper solid wastes disposal
- Avoid burning of wastes or illegally dumping it to any vacant area.
- Establish septic tank to treat the liquid wastes before entering the old fish pond
- Maintain the cleanliness and avoid stacking of used water to prevent mosquito breeding
- The permit holder shall submit quarterly self- monitoring report to City-ENRO

Also, we will conduct quarterly monitoring on the said Establishment to ensure their compliance with the following environmental ordinances:

- RA 9003- Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000
- RA 9275- The Philippine Clean Water Act
- RA 6969- Toxic Substances & Hazardous & Nuclear Waste Control Act

** We do advise to make an urgent response in addressing this matter as soon as you received this inspection report. Failure to comply with the recommendations given above will result to restricted operation or much worse, closure of the business.*
