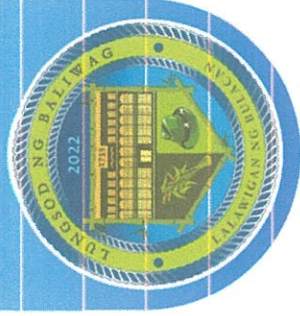

INSPECTION REPORT

Name of Establishment: GOLDEN SUNDAY FARM

Address: 188 P. Camacho, Brgy. Makinabang, Baliwag, Bulacan

Issue: FLIES INFESTATION COMPLAINT

Date of inspection: June 20, 2025 an inspection was conducted by the CAO-Veterinary Division, BPLO, CENRO and Sanitation

Inspection Report: A complaint was received via social media platform that the alledged farm was the caused of flies infestation in the near by housing area located at the posterior portion of the farm. The farm has a total broiler capacity of 70,000 heads but manage to load and harveste a 40,000 heads for the last loading season this June 2025.

Findings:

- The farm harvested the flocks days ago and started cleaning and disinfection when we arrived. Presence of flies was observe in the vicinity of the farm.Foul odor and dirty surroundings of the facilities during the inspection.
- The farm was found out not registered as Animal Facility to the Bureau of Animal Industry as of this date (June 2025). Since it was considered as a commercial poultry farm. It needs to be inspected not only by the Provincial Veterinary Office but also the regional office for compliance and standardization of facilities .

- The farm manager was advised last time that before loading their new flocks they have to report to the barangay as well and city hall to re inspect their facilities but the manager tend to forget the said agreement made between the JIAT.
- The Barangay officials earlier conducted a meeting together with the owner of the farm and farm staff at the Barangay hall a day before we conducted the farm inspection.
- Scattered chicken manure along the entrance of the building that may attract flies .

In regards with the above mentioned issues, CAO VET DIV cited the following recommendations to address the said issues. The list of recommendations are as follows:

Recommendations :

- Follow recommended schedule for fly control to avoid reoccurrence of the said incident.
- Practicing of strict biosecurity measure to avoid future complaints.
- Farm structures renovation.
- Advise to report to the City Agriculture Office for their flock population for loading this coming loading season preferably after the retrofitting of the farm as per the farm manager. Requesting the certifications/permits for the manure and to the future harvest of broiler flocks should be coordinated with the City and Provincial Veterinary Office for proper documentations .
- Application as registered animal facility to the Bureau of Animal Industry (AWA)

Also, we will conduct a follow up monitoring on the said establishments to ensure their compliance with the following ordinances

- Animal Welfare Act
- Avian Influenza Provincial Ordinance
