Findings:

- Without business permit
- The effluents came from the septic tank are over flowing to the canal going to vacant lot.
- Minimal foul odor
- Minimal flies
- 43 heads total No. of fattener pig, 100 heads broiler chicken
- Without environmental permits such as Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC), Discharge permit and Hazardous wastes Generator I.D

In regards with the above-mentioned findings, City-ENRO cited the following recommendations to address the said findings. The lists of recommendations are as follows:

Recommendations:

- Apply to the Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) for the issuance of business permit
- Establish three-layer septic tank to separate the sludge from the effluents
- Ensure the cleanliness of the farm and regularly spray appropriate organic solutions to remove the flies and unpleasant smell in the area
- Always maintain the cleanliness of the farm
- Coordinate to City Agriculture Office for the approval and checking of agricultural practices
- Secure environmental permits such as Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC), Discharge permit and Hazardous wastes Generator I.D to the EMB (Environmental Management Bureau)
- The permit holder shall submit quarterly self- monitoring report to City-ENRO

Also, we will conduct quarterly monitoring on the said Establishment to ensure their compliance with the following environmental ordinances:

- RA 9003- Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000
- RA 9275- The Philippine Clean Water Act

** We do advise to make an urgent response in addressing this matter as soon as you received this inspection report. Failure to comply with the recommendations given above will result to restricted operation or much worse, closure of the business.*
